Call for Bids to Host PAMO/PAMO-G in 2022

The AFRICAN MATHEMATICAL UNION – PAN AFRICAN MATHEMATICAL OLYMPIADS COMMISSION (AMU-PAMOC) is calling for bids to host the PAMO/PAMOG in 2022

CONTENT

Bids should be brief (no more than 5 pages), and include the following information:

1. Expression of interest letter from the Ministry of Education of the bidding country.
2. Host Organization which could be Mathematical Associations, Academic Institutions etc.
3. **Local Organizing Committee (LOC).** At a minimum five memberships, name the following organizers and include a brief bio that highlights prior experience in International or Regional Mathematical Olympiads and organizing conferences:
 - a. Chairs
 - b. Secretary
 - c. Accommodation and logistics Chair(s)
 - d. Contests and related matters Chair(s)
4. **Proposed location.** Provide the following:
 - a. Brief description of the Contests city(s)
 - b. Brief description of possible Activities venues
5. **Planned dates.** PAMO in normally preferred to hold months before International Mathematical Olympiads (IMO) in July each year to serve a selection and training for countries participating in IMO.
6. **Statement of commitment to work with AMU-PAMOC for successful PAMO/PAMO-G.**
7. **Planned direction/organization of the Programme.** The default is that the direction of the PAMO/PAMO-G and the general way it is organized, will not change from year-to-year and follows strictly the annual PAMO Regulations as approved by AMU-PAMOC. However, proposals for any changes are welcome, if they would improve the programme in some way, but cannot be implemented without the written approval of AMU-PAMOC.
8. **Management plan.** Provide an outline of how the programme will be managed, from the time the bid is awarded, to the concluding event. At a minimum the bid should explain what tools will be used, how frequently meetings will be held, who will be responsible for which tasks, and how experiences accumulated at prior PAMO will be utilized.

9. **Budget estimate.** The estimate should provide a plan for completing the Programme with a surplus of funds.
10. **Supporters and sponsors.** List entities that have committed to supporting PAMO 2022 (e.g. the Chairs' home departments) and provide their letters of support. Also, list entities that you plan to approach for support, such as partners in industry.
